## 5 Call for Works

### (1) Details of Application

Messages with the theme of "Peace" **(English)**

### (2) Entry Categories

#### **"Message for Peace" English section**

- A4-size free-form paper (portrait, landscape)
- Within 2 Pages (about 500 words)
- The First Line: the Title
- The Second Line: the School Name
- The Third Line: Grade and Name
- From the fourth line: the Main Text...

### (3) Prizes, etc.

- Each school is required to send Two Excellent Works among them.**

**and**  In the "Message for Peace" English language division, **One Grand Prize Winner**  
**Two Excellence Award Winners** will receive a Certificate and an Additional Prize

- (stationary... etc.).
- The Grand Prize Winner will be invited to Japan with his/her 1 parent or 1 Teacher **(Total 2 Persons)**.
- **Homestay:   Departure: Aug. 9   Return: Aug. 12**

- The Grand Prize Winner will be invited to participate in the "Kanoya City War Remnants Bus Tour" on August 11, 2023 (Friday).

(4) **Selection Method**

- **Choose Two Works** based on judging of each school in Taiwan.
- A final judging will be held and **the Grand Prize Winner and Two Excellence Awards Winners** will be decided by the selection committee Members in Kanoya City.

(5) **Handling of Works**

- The copyright of the works belongs to the organizer.
- The Sent works will not be returned.

(6) **Entry Method**

- **Two Works per One School** must be submitted.
- Each school is required to prepare a separate "**Application Form**" and send it **by e-mail**.
- ※ On the application form, please indicate **the two works chosen by each school in Taiwan** and **the total number of works** submitted by each school in Taiwan.

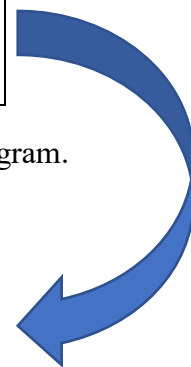

## Human Nature
